The Kath Topping Vocal Award 2022

The Kath Topping Vocal Award 2022 will be the sixteenth award to be made by Kent Chamber Choir in memory of Kath, a much-loved member of the Choir who died suddenly in 2002. She joined Kent County Council as an archivist finally becoming Specialist Services Manager in Kent Libraries. She lived in Maidstone and was a governor of St Simon Stock RC Secondary School.

Singing was a real joy to Kath and her musical and social contribution to Kent Chamber Choir was outstanding through her enthusiasm, loyalty and lovely alto voice. She had told close friends that if she could have her time again, singing would have been the career she would have chosen. Her tragic premature death prompted choir members to seek to remember her and celebrate her life through a bursary fund created to encourage and support young singers from Kent or Medway.

The Kath Topping Memorial Fund was set up in October 2003 with the proceeds of a concert in Rochester Cathedral at which Kent Chamber Choir was joined by its patron, the internationally acclaimed soprano Emma Kirkby, and three of Kent Music School's Youth Choirs in the first performance of "Sing Joyfully", a fitting tribute to Kath.

One or more awards of up to £500 each may be made to provide support for vocal studies such as singing lessons or the purchase of music or scores in the 2022 - 23 academic year.

Successful applicants will be required to submit a receipted invoice(s) by 30th June 2023 in order to claim their Award.

WHO CAN APPLY?

To be eligible to apply, you must be aged between 16 and 23 on 31st August 2022 and your '**family home**' must be in the Kent or Medway Authority Area, even if you personally are currently living outside the county because of college/university study.

The closing date for applications is **27th May 2022**.

WILL AUDITIONS BE HELD?

A shortlist will be produced by 10th June and successful applicants will be invited to an audition during July. Two short contrasting songs (or extracts) should be prepared. They can be either accompanied or unaccompanied and an accompanist will be provided if requested.
